This book tells the story of six very close women friends who, many years ago, started getting together for breakfast every week in the same restaurant. Over the years they spent the morning sharing happiness and unhappiness, supporting each other through whatever was going on. In this book we walk with them as one learns about her unfaithful husband, a couple who spark up a romance with new men in their lives, and another with a serious health condition. The book was very well received by the group, giving a rating of 4-5 on a scale of five. We all enjoyed the characters but were a little challenged trying to keep them straight in the beginning. 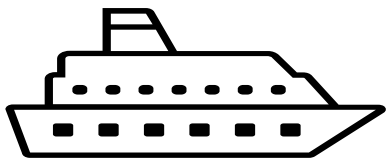

Many of those in attendance have already booked dining times and excursions and encouraged us to book ours as quickly as possible because times are filling up. UPDATE: VA
Healthcare New Multi-
Specialty Clinic in
Vero Beach

Unfortunately, there is a delay in the opening. VA's new multi-specialty clinic in Vero Beach, located at the Indian River VA Clinic (777 37th Street), is undergoing construction and will open in phases, with initial services expected in March 2026 and full activation anticipated by May 2026. I will try and keep everyone updated on the progress as I learn about it. Like we always say "Hurry up and wait"

Recently I was asked about a Veterans ID card. This is what I found:

Your local state may designate "Veteran" on your driver's license to show you are a Veteran.

Your state County may also issue you a Veterans ID card, check with them.

Apply for Veterans benefits and if eligible you will get a VA Identification card.

You can apply for a federal Veterans ID card at:
